# Microsoft Get Licensing Ready is Retiring

As we approach the new year, we want to let you know of an important update: **Microsoft's Get Licensing Ready website is retiring on 1<sup>st</sup> January 2025.**

We understand that this portal has been a valuable resource for many people in the industry, providing Microsoft Licensing, Agreement, and product education, in the form of videos, whitepapers and certified exams. Unfortunately, users will have until 31<sup>st</sup> December to complete any active modules and download their certificates.

The decision to retire the website stems from Microsoft's intention to streamline its resources. Microsoft will instead, direct partners and customers to [Microsoft.com/licensing](https://Microsoft.com/licensing) information pages, as an alternative. This transition will no doubt impact users who rely on the video content and certification process and, to the disappointment of many, it seems unlikely that a similar level of video content and exams will be added to Microsoft's licensing pages.

This raises the question: what do those of us who relied on this platform do next to maintain our Microsoft Licensing and SAM expertise? While there are alternative Microsoft training options out there, very few focus specifically on Microsoft SAM/Licensing. Most focus on technical product functionality and sales. If you exclude those, there are only a small handful of options for on-demand Microsoft Licensing training, and LISA is one of them
